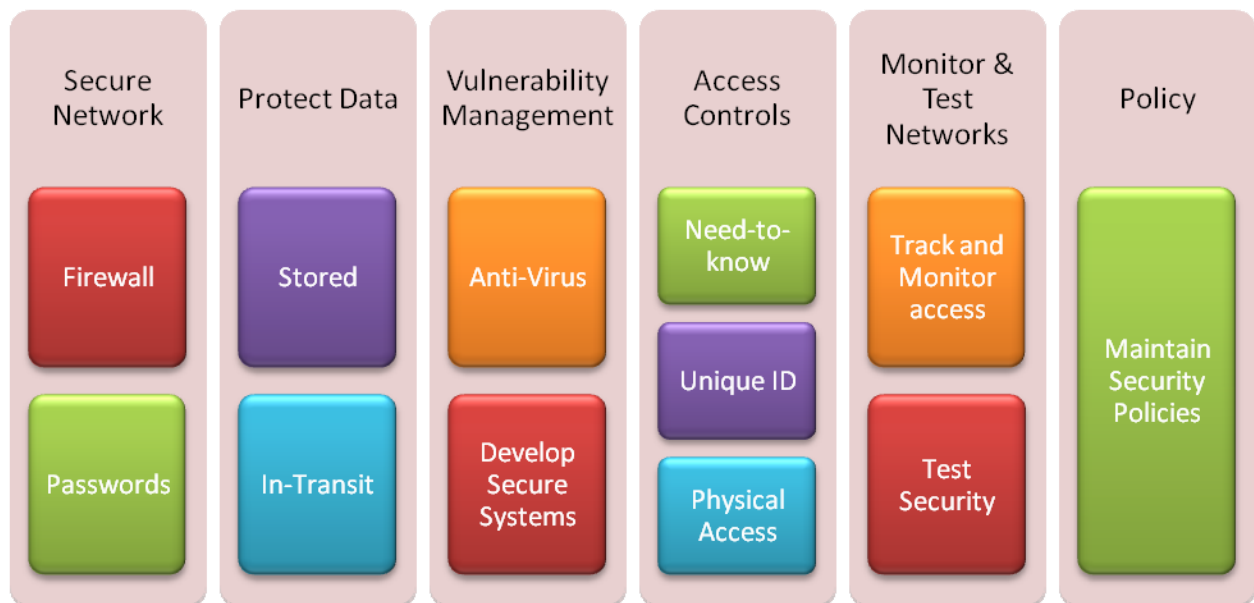


After numerous expensive incidents of identity theft, the payment card industry has developed a set of mandatory security standards. These (the PCI-DSS standards) apply to both merchants that process credit and debit card transactions and the “back office” service providers. On October 1, 2008 an update of this standard was released, version 1.2. This training seminar is designed for retailers and merchants that process fewer than 1 million credit or debit card transactions annually.
